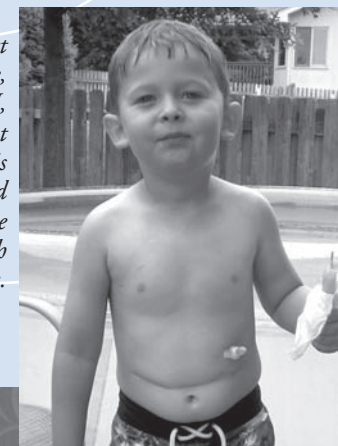




*Rick is now thriving on tube feeding thanks to information from Oley. He travels, hikes, skis and goes white water rafting.*

*Born with short bowel syndrome, Nolan is off HPN, but still dependent on tube feedings. His family has found support and hope by connecting with other Oley families.*



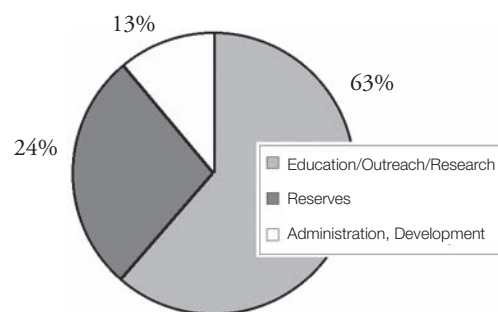

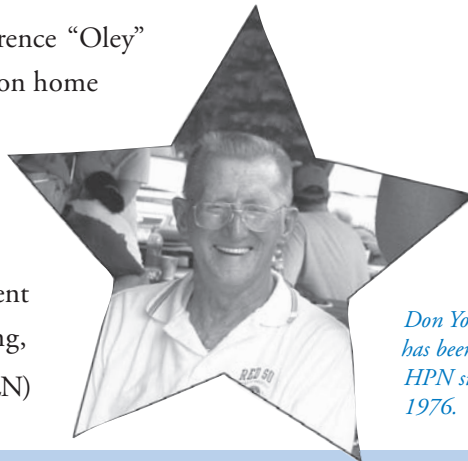


## The Oley Foundation

Founded in 1983 by Lyn Howard, MD, and her patient Clarence “Oley” Oldenburg, the Oley Foundation helps consumers dependent upon home

- **parenteral nutrition** (HPN) where solutions are infused directly into the bloodstream via IV, and
- **enteral nutrition** (HEN) where formula is delivered by tube into the stomach or intestinal tract.

Digestive disorders, ranging from cancer to Crohn’s disease, prevent these consumers from sustaining themselves through normal eating, making long-term home intravenous (HPN) or tube-fed (HEN) nutrition necessary for survival. Patients have lived on these therapies for more than 40 years.

### Information and Support

The Oley Foundation provides its 9,900 members with critical information on such topics as research, health insurance, and medical advances. The Foundation is also a source of support, helping homePEN patients overcome the unique psycho-social challenges they face, such as their inability to eat, altered body image, and the ups-and-downs of chronic illness. All Oley programs and services are offered **FREE of CHARGE** to homePEN patients and their families.

### Oley Foundation Programs

- **LifelineLetter:** a bimonthly newsletter with articles about medical advances and personal experiences, written for homePEN consumers and their families
- **Regional Coordinator Network:** a grassroots network of 50+ volunteers — all homePEN consumers or caregivers — who are the faces of Oley in their regions in the US and Canada. New are affiliate volunteers in Australia, New Zealand, and the UK.
- **Annual Summer Conference:** an opportunity for homePEN consumers, clinicians, providers, and industry representatives to share information and support
- **Information Clearinghouse:** a resource designed for answering questions about homePEN through a toll-free hotline, Web site, online education program, and video tape/DVD library
- **Consumer Networking:** online chat forum and ability to call or email experienced homePEN consumers and caregivers
